Yes, we are having Catfish Days this year and things will be different!! A warm welcome and "Thank You" from the Trempealeau Lions Club for wanting to take part in our annual Catfish Days Parade. This year's Catfish Days events are mainly on Friday and Saturday. The Parade is the only activity planned for Sunday. Due to financial constraints the Parade Committee has zero dollars for parade participation.

**The parade will start at 2:00 pm on Sunday, July 11th, 2021.**

The parade line-up will be at Main and Tenth Streets, starting at 12:30 pm. This year NO numbers will be sent for the line-up for the parade. Line-up will be a **FIRST COME - FIRST-IN-LINE** parade. Please enter the line-up area from the north via Tenth Street or Hwy 35, following the Hwy 35 detour signs, to help us alleviate congestion in the line-up area.

The parade will follow a route starting from Fifth & Main Streets, continuing south on Main Street for two blocks, then eastward past the main viewing areas on Third Street; ending and disbursing at Chase Street. A map showing the location of the line-up area and parade route is on the second page. **The parade will begin promptly at 2:00 pm.**

Again this year we are banning all water hoses, water guns and water balloons. Please keep the safety of all parade spectators in mind by gently throwing candy rather than handing out candy. Please help make this year's parade incident and Covid free.
